NOMINATIONS For the HIGHLY CAPABLE PROGRAM







Do you know of a child that you believe to be intellectually gifted?

If so, you will need to pick up an information packet at Red Rock Elementary School to begin the referral process. Anyone may nominate a student. Testing for the program is in September of each school year.

When considering a student for this program, please note:

- Students need to be in grades K-12.
- We think in terms of behaviors that are comparatively rare, considerably early and significantly more advanced.
- The referral team will look at your student's standardized test scores and their MAP scores. A Cognitive Abilities Test (CoGat) may also be administered.
- In addition, the nominating person will need to complete forms that identify creative and behavioral traits of the student.
